# Mass Exodus in Central Gaza as IDF Advances

150,000 have been forced to flee: UN

**Cairo / Gaza:** Tens of thousands of already displaced Palestinian families took flight again in a new mass exodus in central Gaza on Thursday, where Israeli forces mounting a major advance pounded areas already teeming with those driven out of the north.

Further south, Israeli forces struck the area around a hospital in the heart of Khan Younis, the Gaza Strip's main southern city, where residents feared a new ground push into territory crowded with families made homeless in 12 weeks of war. Israel has escalated its ground war in Gaza sharply since just before Christmas despite public pleas from its closest ally the United States to scale the campaign down in the closing weeks of the year.

The main focus of fighting is now in central areas south of the wetlands that bisect the Gaza Strip, where Israeli forces have ordered civilians out as their tanks advance. Tens of thousands of people fleeing the huge Nusseirat, Bureij and Maghazi districts of central Gaza were heading south or west on

Thursday into the already overwhelmed city of Deir al-Balah along the Mediterranean coast, crowding into hastily built camps of make-shift tents.

"Over 150,000 people — young children, women carrying babies, people with disabilities & the elderly — have nowhere to go," the main UN organisation operating in Gaza, UNRWA, said in a social media post decrying what it called "forced displacement" under Israeli evacua-

tion orders.

The eastern part of Bureij was a theatre of heavy fighting on Thursday morning, with Israeli tanks pushing in from the north and east, residents and militants said. Meanwhile, Khan Younis, the main southern city came under heavy bombardment on Thursday morning from warplanes and tanks near the al-Amal hospital, west of Israeli positions.

## Israel's Cost of War: 160 Soldiers Killed, 3K Injured

Israel's defence ministry says roughly 3,000 members of the country's security forces have been wounded since Oct. 7, nearly 900 of these since Israel began its ground offensive, while more than 160 soldiers have been killed since then. ## China Says Taiwan Hyping up Military Threat, Sends Warplanes Towards Island

**Beijing / Taipei:** China's defence ministry accused Taiwan's government on Thursday of deliberately "hyping up" a military threat from China for electoral gain ahead of elections in just over two weeks' time, but again sent warplanes into the Taiwan Strait.

Taiwan's Jan. 13 presidential and parliamentary election will shape the Chinese-claimed island's relations with Beijing, which over the past four years has ramped up military pressure to assert its sovereignty claims. As the election approaches Taiwan has reported Chinese fighter jets and warships around the island, as well as balloons cross-

sing the sensitive Taiwan Strait, though the military says they are most likely for weather monitoring purposes.

Speaking at a monthly news conference in Beijing, Chinese defence ministry spokesperson Wu Qian said Taiwan's government was to blame for the tensions. "The Democratic Progressive Party (DPP) authorities are deliberately hyping up the so-called 'military threat from the mainland' and exaggerating tensions," said Wu, referring to Taiwan's ruling party.

"This is entirely to seek electoral gain," he said. Reuters

## Toy Story: Alibaba Faces Suit Over Squishmallows

A judge in New York has ruled that Alibaba must face a lawsuit by a US toymaker alleging that the Chinese ecommerce giant's online platforms were used to sell counterfeit Squishmallows.


Judge Jesse Furman of the Southern District Court of New York refused Alibaba's request to dismiss the case filed by Kelly Toys Holdings, which makes the popular plush toys.

Kelly Toys is owned by Jazwares, a toy company whose parent company Alleghany is controlled by billionaire Warren Buffett's Berkshire Hathaway.

There was no immediate comment by Alibaba, China's biggest ecommerce company.

Among other things, Alibaba based its motion to dismiss on how it was named in the lawsuit as Alibaba.com instead of its formal corporate name.

In its complaint, Kelly Toys said sales of faked Squishmallows by merchants using Alibaba sites continued despite earlier lawsuits demand-



ing they be stopped. The company had earlier filed the case to stop about 90 ecommerce companies from selling counterfeit versions of the toys. Alibaba was named as a defendant in March.

"Kelly Toys alleges that,

notwithstanding that awareness, infringing listings — including some by the Merchant Defendants — have continued to proliferate on the Alibaba platforms," Furman wrote.

## Britain Lifts Costly Brexit Obstacles for French Students

Britain on Thursday lifted some costly obstacles placed on school trips post-Brexit — but only for students from France as campaigners called for all EU countries to benefit. The U-turn follows talks earlier this year over the issue between Prime Minister Rishi Sunak and French President Emmanuel Macron. French and EU nationals at schools in France who cross the Channel for a language-learning holiday will now need to carry only a simple identity card, as was the case before the UK formally departed the EU. While non-EU nationals attending French schools will still need to present a passport to enter the UK on a language-learning holiday, London has scrapped the need for them to have a visa costing £115 (\$147). ## Xiaomi Unveils its First EV, Bets \$10b on Electric Foray

The billionaire co-founder of Xiaomi unveiled the company's first electric vehicle on Thursday, declaring ambitions to become a top global carmaker in 15 to 20 years and compete against Tesla and Porsche.

The SU7, which stands for Speed Ultra, rolled onto a stage at the China National Convention Center in Beijing with no drivers visible, ending a presentation by CEO and co-founder Lei Jun in front of thousands of people. Lei spent hours detailing the car's features, which include a range of up to 800 kilometers on a single charge, adjustable spoilers, unique colors and a top speed of 265 kilometers an hour. The five-seat sedan will be powered by batteries from Chinese market leaders Contemporary Amperex Technology and BYD, depending on whether it has a single or dual motor configuration.

Xiaomi's EV foray is a \$10 billion wager by Lei that his company can shake up the transport sector

much as it did smartphones a decade ago. "Xiaomi's goal is to make a dream car that is as good as Porsche and Tesla," Lei said Thursday at the launch event.

Lei has previously said Xiaomi intends the SU7 to rival Porsche's Taycan Turbo in terms of performance and Tesla's Model S in technology features. The Model S starts at 698,900 yuan and the Taycan at 898,000 yuan, which is much higher than the medium price bracket of 200,000 yuan to 300,000 yuan that many expect the SU7 to fall into. Xiaomi hasn't yet said how much the SU7 will cost. Lei hinted it could be anywhere between 99,000 yuan and 400,000 yuan. The SU7 is due to go on sale next year and can go from 0 to 100 kph in 2.78 seconds.

Lei said, It will come with a motor that has 21,000 revolutions a minute, which he said is higher than the Model S and Taycan Turbo.




